3. Define puerperal pyrexia. Discuss the causes and management of same.
4. A primigravida at 32 weeks of pregnancy reported to antenatal clinic with history of severe head ache and blurring of vision. On examination, her BP was 170/110 mm Hg. Discuss further evaluation and management.
5. Classify incoordinate uterine action. Discuss the causes, clinical features and management of obstructed labor.
6. What are the indications for Caesarean Section? Describe the operative steps, complications and post operative management of the same.
7. Discuss the causes and management of neonatal jaundice.
8. Describe the clinical features and complications of a preterm neonate.
9. Discuss the indications, contraindications and side effects of oral contraceptive pills.
10. Discuss the role, advantages and disadvantages of barrier contraceptives.
