Answer the following (10 marks x = 50 marks)

"A" was instituted on the basis of a written complaint by Rajesh Kumar Sinha, Drug Inspector, (10) Nalanda alleging that on secret information, a raid was conducted in Sanjivani Hospital, Biharsharif, Nalanda. During the raid, it was found that the accused persons tried and made attempts to destroy the medicines. The raiding team could lay its hands upon Hologram of Bihar Government supply, which is not meant for sale generally. A Medical Hall also was found to be existing near the Doctors' Chambers without any valid licence. It was, therefore, alleged that without any valid licence, the accused persons were engaged in manufacturing medicines, thereby violating the various provisions of the I.P.C. and the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

- B. Were police correct in registering the complaint and investigating?
