3. A 60 year postmenopausal woman complains of foul smelling bloody discharge per vagina. On examination there is a growth arising from anterior lip of cervix which extends further down for 2 cm on anterior vaginal wall. Per-rectal examination reveals that rectal mucosa is free and entire parametrium is supple. What is the stage and justify? Write the further management of this case.
