Human behavior is a complex thing. We are all interested in understanding it. The teachers teach something to the students. The knowledge of educational psychology enables him to understand an individual. He gains in self- understanding. He knows his assets and limitations

in relation to the realization of educational objectives. It develops in him right attitudes and perspectives leading to a well- knitted personality. His duty is to know how much of a subject he should teach and how should he perform this task? He learns the subject matter which is descriptive, concrete and comprehensible to students. He should proceed from the concrete to the abstract, from simple to complex and from the known to the unknown, in the initial stage of teaching any subject. He should learn how progressive teaching procedures such as the project method and play way are based on sound principles of learning.
