The position of women in India rather started dwindling to insignificance since attacks in the eleventh century. By this time, the country was unfortunately divided in to different states each vying for superiority over the other. A number of small feudal states too came up. This made the country vulnerable to foreign onslaught. Saurashtra, having more than two hundred feudal states saw the fall of Somnath. These attacks and the disunity among Indian Kings compelled the people to have many changes in their social set-up. Hindu community was now finally divided into a large number of sub-castes rather a village or a region converting into a caste to look after its own affairs. The Hindu modes of morality called for the value of chastity and virginity. The wars with the invaders were responsible for the destruction of temples and centres of education. The age of illiteracy started and affected women the most. Martial education could be imparted to men but the women were confined to their homes to save them the lust of the invader. Purdah system started and women were confined to the household chores only. It has a devastating effect in the status of women. Even earlier they were dependent on man for he was the bread winner. Now they started leading a confined life-more or less akin to slavery. A few Jijabias or Tarabais apart, the common woman was removed to the lowest step in the social ladder.
