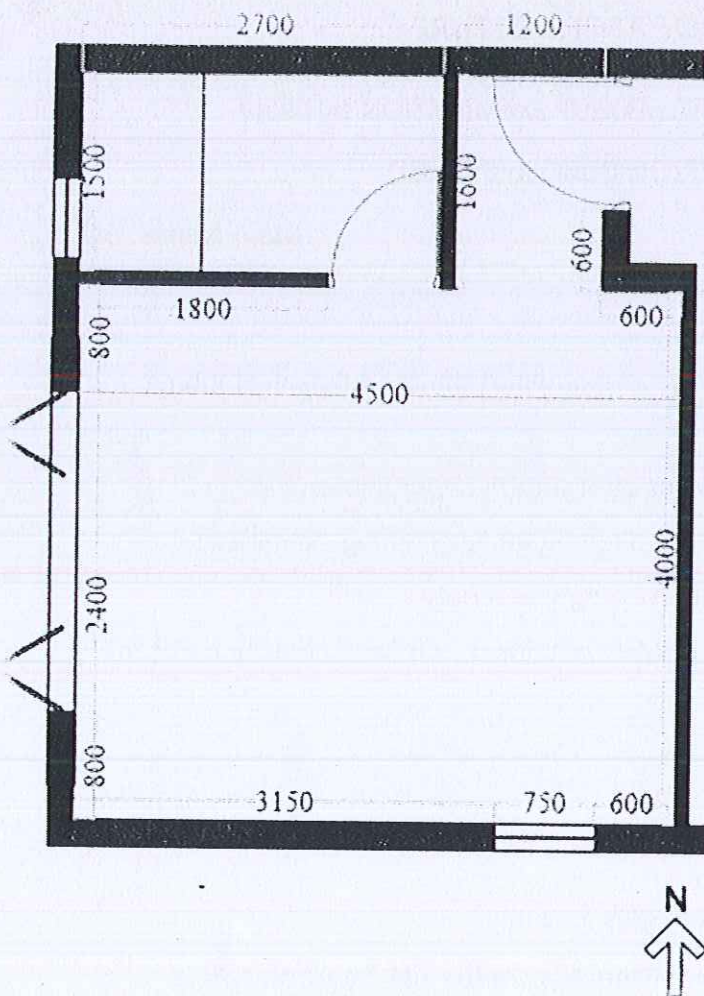
INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES
