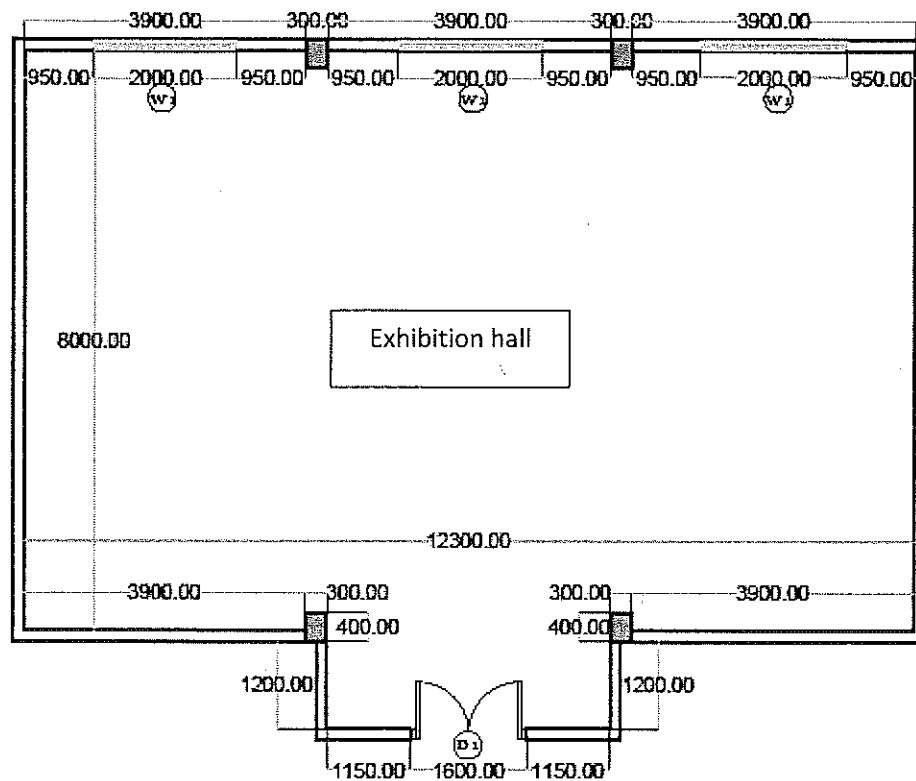
- Anthropometric data and its relation to the design of displays.

- Conceptual Design drawings
- Finalization of design with reason for design decision.
- Refinement of final design.

- Floor plan showing the furniture layout, circulation, clearance etc. - (8mks)
- False ceiling design showing lighting /fans /HVAC systems etc. -(4mks)
- Flooring layout/design with material specification. -(4mks)
- Focus wall Elevations mentioning Material/Finishes used. -(4mks)
- Views of important spaces. -(5mks)
- Min 2 Sections (Longitudinal and transverse) -(4mks)
- Design Details of display panels and additional fittings -(3mks)
- Furniture details for display, small seating, souvenir shop (storage cabinets, display units etc.) -(3mks)
