There is a quaint little story about a very small frog that fell into a deep rut. Try as he would, he couldn't jump out. Some frog friends came by and looked in. "What's the matter?" they asked. "I can't get out; I have tried all morning," he replied. They couldn't help him, so they went their way. That afternoon they happened to pass the spot again and looked in. Their little friend was gone. Searching about, they found him hopping around in the grass. "We thought you couldn't get out." "I couldn't," he said, "but a big truck came along and I had to." A crisis, a threat, or pain can be a powerful motivator.

Some realistic steps you can take to help you achieve a better self-image are given below. Merely reading them will probably do you very little good. You will need to pick out one specific step at a time, write it on a card, and carry it with you. Refer to it often during the week. Jot down on the card ways in which you can implement your goal. Carrying the card with you and looking at it frequently will activate your unconscious mind. Remember, as you begin, there are no free lunches, no magic cures, and no simple solutions for life-long problems. It took you all those years to become the person you are. It will take time to change your self-image.

I am not suggesting a palpitating, frenzied struggle, but a single-minded long-range programme. Significance is given to this singleness of purpose. Erich Fromm suggests that learning to love requires giving it priority. In the acquiring of an art, disciplined effort is essential, whether it is learning to play a guitar, to paint, or rear children; and diligent, disciplined effort is most often achieved alone. One may learn principles in a class, or a group, but one usually achieves competence in any art or skill by practicing it alone.
