

Visibility, Workflow and Communication





Key Features of the Workflow

For the Library

- Research Dashboard account to approve article eligibility under the agreement;
- The library has full control over which articles to approve;
- Real time self service reporting;
- Reduces administration around OA;
- Dedicated workflow contacts at T&F.

For the Researcher

- Affiliation based workflow: matching engine identifies eligibility;
- Clear messaging at each stage of the process to alert them to the agreement in place;
- Communication to confirm funding approval;
- Choice of Creative Commons licence.



Workflow for a Full Open Access Article at Taylor & Francis




- Author informed of agreement
- Article populates Submitted Articles Tab
- Institution has the option to preapprove

If pre-approved, funds are drawdown from the Full OA Fund




Author Submission Flow - Charges step




The system has recognised that the institution is part of the agreement and therefore directs the author to this page, letting them know that they may be eligible for APC funding

Authors can choose if they do not want to request for APC funding and generate their quote or enter a discount code if they have been provided with one







Authors receive a confirmation email when they submit their manuscript The article then appears on the Submitted Articles tab on dashboard, the library here can pre-approve the article for APC funding



Acceptance email to author






